## Requirements

### Degree Requirements

A minimum of 90 credits numbered 100 or above must be completed to qualify for the Associate in General Studies degree, as described in the distribution and electives requirements sections below.

### General Education Requirements

Must complete a minimum of 10 credits in each of the following areas: communication, humanities, natural science, social science for a minimum total of 40 distribution credits.
