SPANISH (CCN) (SPAN&)

SPAN& 121 Spanish I 5 Credits

Introduces the four basic skills of the Spanish language: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Studies the language within its cultural context

Prerequisite: None.

Distribution Requirements: Humanities

SPAN& 122 Spanish II 5 Credits

Builds on SPAN& 121 to work toward mastery of first-year Spanish, with focus on listening, speaking, reading and writing. Continues to study the language within its cultural context.

Prerequisite: Prerequisite: SPAN& 121 with a C or better or instructor's permission.

Distribution Requirements: Humanities

SPAN& 123 Spanish III 5 Credits

Builds on SPAN& 122 to work toward mastery of first-year Spanish, with focus on listening, speaking, reading, and writing. The language continues to be studied within its cultural context.

Prerequisite: Prerequisite: SPAN& 122 with a C or better or instructor's permission.

Distribution Requirements: Humanities

SPAN& 221 Intermediate Spanish I 5 Credits

Builds on first-year Spanish with focus on expansion of communicative skills, comprehension, and cultural competency. This course takes place at The Evergreen State College.

Prerequisite: Prerequisite: SPAN& 123 with a C or better or instructor's permission.

Distribution Requirements: Humanities

SPAN& 222 Intermediate Spanish II 5 Credits

Consolidation and expansion of communicative skills in speaking, reading and writing acquired in introductory Spanish language courses. Increasing cultural competency. This course was formerly known as SPAN 202, Intermediate Spanish II.

Prerequisite: Prerequisite: SPAN& 221 with a C or better or instructor¿s permission.

Distribution Requirements: Humanities

SPAN& 223 Intermediate Spanish III 5 Credits

Builds on SPAN& 222 with focus on expansion of communicative skills, comprehension, and cultural competency. This course takes place at The Evergreen State College.

Prerequisite: Prerequisite: SPAN& 222 with a C or better or instructor¿s permission.
